Local Rules & Conditions of Competition

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Terms of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following

Scorecard: The CC of Pittsfield scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

Tees: Play will be from the GOLD Tee Markers.

Out of Bounds: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes, white lines, boundary fence posts, club parking lots/driveway, granite curbing and public roads.

Hole #5 – Left Hole #10 – Right (Road)

Hole #8 – Right (Starting ~120 yards from Green), Behind Green Hole #18 – Behind Green (Parking Lot)

Hole #9 - Right (Fence > Curbing > Parking Lot)

Red Penalty Areas: Defined by a red line. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole #2 – Left, Right Hole #10 – Left of Green

Hole #3 – Right of & Behind Green Hole #11 – Front of Tee, Left, Right, Behind Green

Hole #4 — Right Hole #12 — Front of Tee, Left, Right Hole #5 — Front of Tee Hole #14 — Behind Green

 Hole #5 – Front of Tee
 Hole #14 – Behind Gre

 Hole #7 – Left off Tee, Right
 Hole #16 – Left, Right

 Hole #8 – Right (Up until ~120 yards from Green)
 Hole #17 – Right

Yellow Penalty Areas: Defined by a yellow line. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole #2 - Front of Green Hole #12 - Front of Tee Hole #15 - Front of Tee

Abnormal Course Conditions: All cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas and white lined areas tying into cart paths. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Hole #6 – If the protective fencing on Hole #3 and/or Hole #13 interferes with a player's stance, swing, lie of the ball or line of play, as an additional relief option, the player may use the Drop Zone provided. This additional option is allowed **ONLY** if the ball is in play nearer the hole than where the Drop Zone is located.

Hole #17 – The Tennis Court(s) behind the Green are considered an obstruction.

- Hole #18 1) The Maintenance Area, Cart Barn, and surrounding Cart Paths on the left are considered ONE obstruction (defined by **BLUE DOTS**). As an additional relief option, a player may use the nearest Drop Zone provided.
 - 2) Tennis Court(s) are considered an obstruction as an additional relief option, a player may use the nearest Drop Zone provided.
 - 3) The Club House, Cart Path, and Stonewall behind the Green are considered ONE obstruction as an additional relief option, a player may use the nearest Drop Zone provided.

No Play Zones: All cultivated flower beds are considered NO PLAY ZONES. Players must take relief under Rule 16.1f.

<u>Power Lines</u>: If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit the power line (or tower or a wire or pole supporting a power line) during the play of **Hole** #7 and/or Hole #10, the player MUST replay the stroke from the spot where that stroke was made (Model Local Rule E-11).

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed with white painted lines are considered GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Relief from Seams of Cut Turf: If a player's ball lies in or touches a seam of cut turf or a seam interferes with the player's area of intended swing, The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. But interference does NOT exist if the seam only interferes with the player's stance. All seams within the area of cut turf are treated as the same seam in taking relief.

Wooden/Blue Stakes/Blue Painted Lines: The Wooden/Blue Stakes and Blue Painted Lines scattered throughout the golf course have no status, and are movable obstructions.

Integral Objects: All stonewalls (with the exception of the stonewall behind the Green on Hole #18) and rock outcroppings are integral objects, relief without penalty is **NOT** permitted.

<u>Pace of Play:</u> Pace for this round is 4 hours and 36 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping within a hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.
