

2024 U.S. Girls' Junior Amateur & Senior Women's Open Qualifier Captains Golf Course - Starboard (Brewster, MA) NOTICE TO PLAYERS



This information supplements the Championship Entry. See the USGA Hard Card for Local Rules and Terms of the Competition for USGA Championships.

SCORECARD: The Captains GC scorecard is unofficial and has no status

TEES: Play is from the WHITE USGA tee markers for the U.S. Girls' Junior Amateur Qualifier.

TEES: Play is from the BLUE USGA tee markers for the U.S. Senior Women's Open Qualifier.

<u>INTEGRAL OBJECTS:</u> All stonewalls and natural outcroppings of rock are considered integral objects from which relief without penalty is not permitted.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white skates.

<u>Hole #5</u> – Right & Behind Green (*Stakes*)

Hole #6 – Left (*Stakes*)

Hole #7 – Left (Stakes)

RED PENALTY AREAS: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the red stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole #4 – Left of Green

Hole #5 – Left

Hole #14 - Left

<u>GROUND UNDER REPAIR:</u> Areas enclosed with white paint. White lined areas tying into immovable obstructions have the same status as the obstruction.

<u>ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS</u>: All french drains, cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas and white lined areas tying into cart paths are considered abnormal course conditions.

<u>Hole #7</u> – If the protective netting left of the fairway interferes with a player's stance, swing, lie of the ball <u>or line of play</u>, as an additional relief option, the player may use the Drop Zone provided. See Rule 16.1

<u>Note</u>: Captains GC's nautical themed 150-yard markers and split-rail fences bordering cart paths are considered abnormal course conditions. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

<u>IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREENS:</u> If an immovable obstruction (and a player's ball) is in a part of the general area – *cut to fairway height or less* – within two club-lengths of the *putting green* and within two club-lengths of the ball, and intervenes with the line of play, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.

<u>PACE OF PLAY:</u> Pace for this round is **4 hours and 34 minutes.** Please ensure that you are keeping with the group in front of you and monitor your pace by checking the times on your scorecard.

<u>TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE:</u> If there is a tie, a sudden death playoff will be held to determine the qualifying spot as well as the alternate positions. The playoff will take place on a hole or holes to be determinted.

Qualifying Spots (Senior Women's Open): 3 players Alternates: 2 players
