NOTICE TO PLAYERS



This information supplements the Championship Entry. See the USGA Hard Card for Local Rules and Terms of the Competition for USGA Championships.

SCORECARD: The Captains GC scorecard is unofficial and has no status

TEES: Play is from the **WHITE** USGA tee markers for the **U.S. Girls' Junior Amateur Qualifier**.

TEES: Play is from the **BLUE** USGA tee markers for the **U.S. Senior Women's Open Qualifier**.

INTEGRAL OBJECTS: All stonewalls and natural outcroppings of rock are considered integral objects from which relief without penalty is not permitted.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes.

Hole #5 – Right & Behind Green (*Stakes*)

Hole #6 – Left (*Stakes*)

Hole #7 – Left (*Stakes*)

RED PENALTY AREAS: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the red stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole #4 – Left of Green

Hole #5 – Left

Hole #14 – Left

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Areas enclosed with white paint. White lined areas tying into immovable obstructions have the same status as the obstruction.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: All french drains, cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas and white lined areas tying into cart paths are considered abnormal course conditions.

Hole #7 – If the protective netting left of the fairway interferes with a player's stance, swing, lie of the ball or line of play, as an additional relief option, the player may use the Drop Zone provided. See Rule 16.1

***Note:** Captains GC's nautical themed 150-yard markers and split-rail fences bordering cart paths are considered abnormal course conditions. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.*

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREENS: If an immovable obstruction (and a player's ball) is in a part of the general area – *cut to fairway height or less* – within two club-lengths of the *putting green* and within two club-lengths of the ball, and intervenes with the line of play, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.

PACE OF PLAY: Pace for this round is **4 hours and 34 minutes**. Please ensure that you are keeping with the group in front of you and monitor your pace by checking the times on your scorecard.

TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE: If there is a tie, a sudden death playoff will be held to determine the qualifying spot as well as the alternate positions. The playoff will take place on a hole or holes to be determined.

Qualifying Spots (Girls' Junior): 2 players **Alternates: 2 players**

Qualifying Spots (Senior Women's Open): 3 players **Alternates: 2 players**
