Local Rules & Terms of Competition

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Terms of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following Local Rules:

Preferred Lies: If a player's ball lies in a part of the General Area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by MARKING, LIFTING & PLACING the original ball or another ball within **one** club length that is not nearer the hole than the spot of the original ball and is in the General Area. The ball may also be cleaned when lifted.

Scorecard: The Marion GC scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

Tees: Play will be from the Club's **Blue** Tee Markers.

Out of Bounds: Defined by the inside edge at ground level of all white stakes, white lines, boundary fence posts, and club parking lot/driveway. When Out of Bounds is defined by a fence, a ball is considered Out of Bounds when it is completely OVER the fence.

Hole #3/Hole #12 – Behind Green (Stakes)

Hole #4/Hole #13 – Right of & Behind Green (Fence)

Hole #6/Hole #15 – Right of Green (Fence)

Hole #8/Hole #17 – Left of & Behind Green (Stonewall → Stakes)

Red Penalty Areas: Defined by red lines. In the absence of a line, the red stakes define the edge of the penalty area.

Hole #2/ Hole #11 – In Front of Tee

Abnormal Course Conditions: All cart paths (paved or unpaved), roads (paved or unpaved), their immediate extensions/adjacent worn areas and white lined areas tying into cart paths. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed with white painted lines are considered GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

No Play Zone(s): All cultivated flower beds are **No Play Zone(s)**. Players **MUST** take relief under Rule 16.1f.

Integral Object: All stonewalls, and rock outcroppings are integral objects, relief without penalty is NOT permitted.

Pace of Play: Pace for this round is *4 hours and 30 minutes*. Please ensure that you are keeping within a hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.
