## **Local Rules & Notice to Competitors**

The Rules of Golf, Mass Golf Hard Card, and Terms of Competitions for Mass Golf Championships govern all play except as modified by the following local rules:

**Scorecard:** The Crestwood scorecard is unofficial and has no status.

## Tees:

Division 1 will play from the **BLUE** Mass Golf Tee Markers Division 2 will play from the **BLACK** Mass Golf Tee Markers

<u>**Out of Bounds:**</u> Defined by white stakes, white lines, and boundary fence posts. All parking areas are OUT of BOUNDS and are defined by the paved edge of the parking lot.

Hole 3 – Left (Stakes → Road)Hole 9 – Behind Green (Clubhouse/Maintenance)Hole 4 – Left (Road)Hole 15 – Behind Green (Stakes)Hole 5 – Left (Road)Hole 16 – Right (Stakes)Hole 6 – Left (Road)Hole 17 – Right & Behind Green (Stakes)Hole 7 – Left (Road)Hole 18 – Right & Behind Green (Stakes → Line)

Red Penalty Areas: Defined by red stakes or lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the penalty area.

Hole 2 – Behind Green
Hole 4 – Behind Green
Hole 5 – Right
Hole 7 – Right (Pond), Behind Green Right
Hole 8 – Right (Pond)
Hole 9 – Front of Tee, Right, & Behind Green
Hole 10 – Right of & Behind Green
Hole 11 – Behind Green
Hole 12 – Right
Hole 13 – Left
Hole 18 – Left

Yellow Penalty Areas: Defined by yellow stakes or lines. In the absence of a line, the stakes define the penalty area.

Hole 5 - Pond\*\*\*

Hole 18 - Front of Tee

Hole 10 - Right of Tee

\*\*\*As an additional relief option for yellow penalty area relief on Hole 5, a player may use the entire forward tee as a dropping zone.

<u>Abnormal Course Conditions</u>: All French drains, cart paths, roads (paved or unpaved) and their extensions are considered obstructions.

Ground Under Repair: Areas enclosed with white paint are defined as Ground Under Repair.

<u>Decorative Flower Areas:</u> Mulched decorative flower areas are Ground Under Repair No Play Zones. Free relief **MUST** be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 16.1f.

Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Greens: For a ball in the general area, relief may be taken under 16.1b when both the ball and obstruction lie in an area cut to fairway height or less. The obstruction must be located: i.) On or within two club-lengths of the putting green, ii.) On the player's line of play, and iii.) The ball must be within two club-lengths of the obstruction.

Integral Objects: All stonewalls and rock outcroppings are integral, relief without penalty is NOT permitted.

<u>Pace of Play:</u> Pace for this round is 4 hours and 35 minutes. Please ensure that you are keeping within one hole of the group in front of you and within the time par printed on your scorecard.
